



By using the Global Sustainable Tourism Criteria (GSTC) as the framework for the sustainability assessment process, the tool will take you through each aspect of sustainability: management, socio-economic, erwiranmental, cultural - to develop an overall picture of how sustainable your business already is, and what you can do to improve your performance to third-party assessment standards.

The results can be collated and displayed in a series of reporting formats for either self-assessment or expert evaluation to provide the basis for developing an SME Sustainability Certification Business Plan to Implement your Going Green ideas.




